

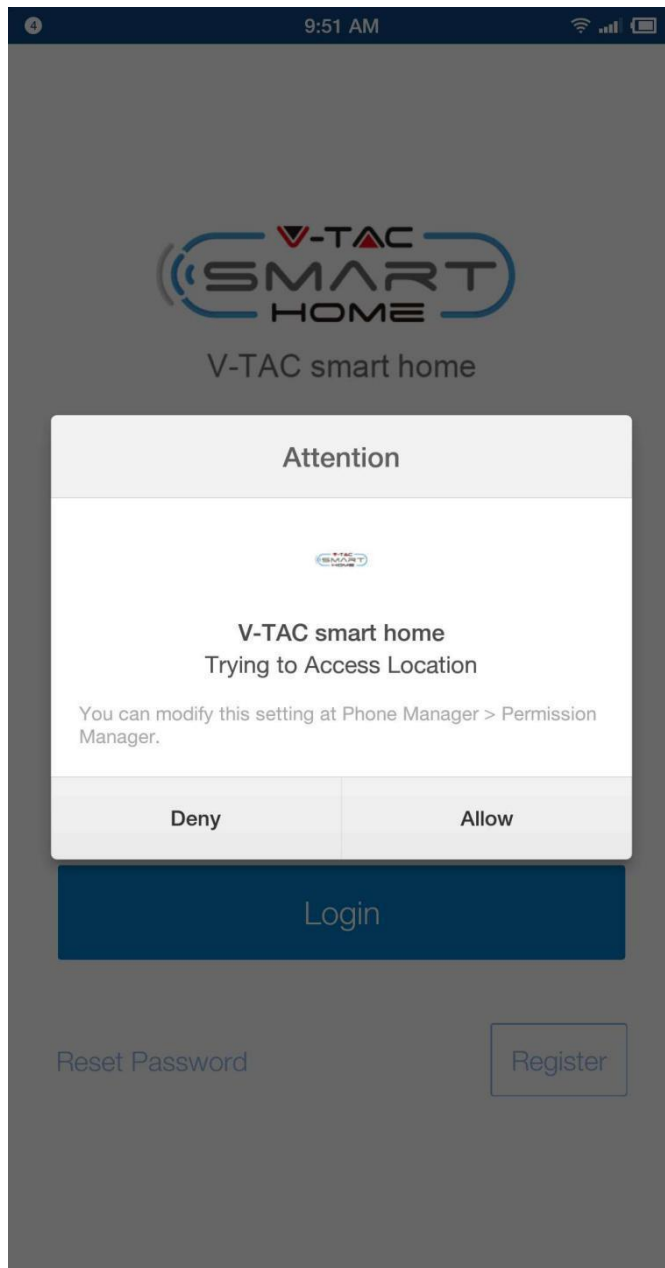
V-TAC APP Permissions Explained

When installing the V-TAC app on your phone or updating to a new version, it would require certain permissions in order to function on your phone.

For example, the app might need to use your phone's camera, or track your location. You can view and manage the permissions and choose which one to grant. It is important to learn about these permissions as denying them, because of worrying about your privacy and data for example, can affect your usage of the app and some of its functions.

We will introduce you all the permissions V-TAC app asks for. Please note that once you have denied these permissions, related functions will not work.

Get location info: Enables auto-search and adding devices via WLAN. Allowing this permission will enable the app to read your WLAN info only. Note that it does not read or obtain your location. Permission notification is shown as below :



By refusing the permission:

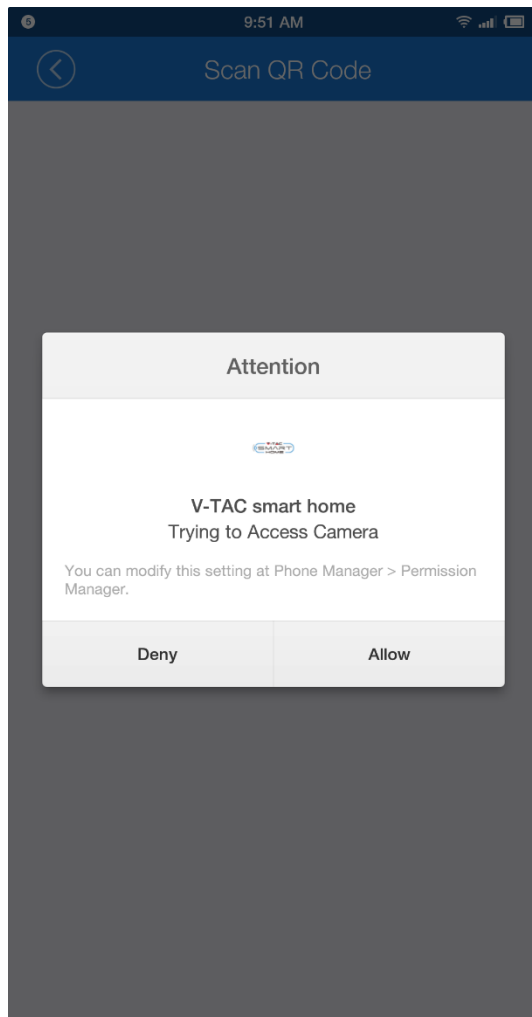
The app will not be able to auto-search and add devices.

Many users complain that they fail to add the products on the app because they denied this permission.

By allowing this permission, the app can:

Scan QR code to read the user manual of V-TAC supported products.

Scan the QR code on GPRS/GSM and Bluetooth devices for pairing.



By refusing the permission:

The app will NOT be able to scan the user guide QR codes.

The app will NOT be able to scan the QR code on GSM/GPRS and Bluetooth devices for pairing.
